Purpose of the Scholarship Call

- The scholarships are part of the broader Caribbean Digital Transformation Project (CARDTP), aim to increase access to digital services, technologies, and skills, ultimately boosting digital connectivity, digital public services, and technology-enabled businesses and jobs.
- ► To enhance digital skills and technology adoption within the Eastern Caribbean, preparing individuals and businesses for the future jobs and economy.

Eligibility Criteria

Who can apply?

Persons:

- Ages 18 years and over
- A citizen or permanent resident of an eligible OECS Member State, with a proven record of residence in the country of at least five years
- Aspiring and current professionals looking to upskill
- Recent graduates eager to break into tech-driven careers
- Entrepreneurs and freelancers looking to enhance their digital expertise.









Eligibility Criteria

Who are we looking for?

Persons who can demonstrate:

- **Basic Computer Skills**
- Access to a Reliable Internet Connection
- **Device Compatibility**
- Technological Literacy
- Time Commitment
- Self-Motivation and Discipline









Application Procedure

- How to Apply?
- Choose a course from the <u>catalogue</u>
- Check that you meet all the requirements and conditions of eligibility identified
- Complete the <u>online application form</u>
- Upload required documents
- Check your inbox regularly (including your SPAM) to see if you have been selected.
- What are the Supporting Documents?
- A completed application form
- A copy of your National ID
- A selfie of you holding your ID
- Certificates (where applicable)









Application Procedure

- What is the Selection Process?
- Stage 1 Eligibility review and shortlisting
- Stage 2 Selected candidates invited to submit a video interview
- Stage 3 Assessment of the video interviews
- Stage 4 Notification email to successful candidates.
- How to access the Scholarship?
- Receive a Scholarship Award Letter
- Sign the OECS Commission Scholarship Acceptance Form
- The OECS Commission pays your full tuition/examination/certification fees to training providers.









Scholarship Participation

- What is the duration for participation?
- 16 weeks
- What will be required from the training provider?
- Use the relevant invitation/access code to join the training portal
- Engage with the learning material
- Successfully complete the training programme
- Pass any examinations to receive the relevant certification.
- What with be required from The UWI Global Campus?
- Join The UWI Learning Management System (The Learning Exchange)
- Participate fully in the **Empowering for Success in the Workplace** programme
- Complete the Life Skills, Mentorship and Job Coaching modules.

- Training available from May 26












