The Rowe Fund is a charitable program established in 1948 as part of the Organization of American States (OAS). The Rowe Fund provides financial aid in the form of interest-free loans of up to \$15,000 to citizens of Latin American and Caribbean countries (F or J visa holders) who have been admitted to or are currently enrolled in their last two years of undergraduate, graduate, or postgraduate studies at universities in the United States. This supplementary financial aid helps pay a portion of their tuition or living expenses. Applications are received and considered monthly, with a cut-off date of the fifth of each month.

Eligible Rowe Fund recipients can simultaneously apply for a supplementary scholarship of \$2,000. We make the application process simple and efficient, allowing students to submit their applications directly. We trust that you will find this information useful and consider sharing it among your UWI students and alumni who plan to further their studies at universities in the United States.
