SWTRC Continues



The research arm of the Centre as you may have seen in the previous issue, engages in ground-breaking research in Jamaica and as well as the Caribbean Region.

Most recently, the Centre's face-to-face classes and upcoming offerings were challenged by the COVID-19 Pandemic. In order to maintain the SWTRC legacy, quick decisions had to be made.
