Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons for the post of **Lecturer/Senior Lecturer** in **Anatomy** in the Department of Preclinical and Health Sciences, Faculty of Medical Sciences at The University of The West Indies, Cave Hill Campus.

Qualifications/Experience:

The successful applicant should be a graduate from a recognized university, with a postgraduate qualification (PhD or MD) in Anatomy. A medical qualification (MBBS or equivalent), and a track record of research and peer-reviewed publications and/or evidence of grant awards/extramural funding will be assets. A high-quality teaching track record in all aspects of anatomy (gross, histology and embryology), within an undergraduate medical education programme or a health profession education setting.

The successful applicant should also have:

- a minimum of five years of teaching expertise as Lecturer in a cadaver-based course with experience in cadaveric dissection (for the Senior Lecturer position)
- evidence of digital innovation in pedagogy and teaching practice including assessments and curriculum development in collaboration with other academics and colleagues
- effective oral and communication skills in English

Appointment as Senior Lecturer or Lecturer will be according to qualifications, teaching and research experience and achievements.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The appointee will be required to advance anatomy as an academic discipline in the Faculty of Medical Sciences and responsibilities will include:

- Coordinating classroom and laboratory instruction, including teaching and assessment, in all aspects of human anatomy as well as additional departmental courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels
- Ensuring upkeep of gross anatomy and histology laboratory in accordance with regional board and accreditation standards
- Fulfilling academic duties including conducting research activities, student advising and mentoring
- Taking on administrative tasks of the Department and Faculty
- Contributing to / leading in the development of postgraduate training and supervision in the areas of special expertise.
